



Methodology & Approach

Methodology and Approach:

Analysis of the report is based on "Likely Voters" Model. Voters who indicated they will not vote were excluded from the overall analysis for the primaries and general elections head-to-head.



Comparative analysis for the April 2022 poll was adjusted to reflect "Likely Voters" only.

Sample Size: 5,490

Confidence Interval: 99%

Margin of Error: MoE of ±1.737%

Population of voters in the 75 constituencies: 4,877,028

Sampling Method:

- 75 constituencies were selected randomly using simulation model.
- Out of the 75 constituencies randomly selected, 41 were won by the NPP and 34 were won by the NDC in the 2020 general elections.

Sampling Frame

- The 2020 Electoral Commissions voters' register was used as a sampling frame for the purpose of allocating sample size to each constituency.
- Allocation of sample to each constituency on basis of registered voters in the constituencies relative to the 75 constituencies selected.
- For each constituency selected, the location for the interview was also selected randomly from three Electoral Areas of the constituency.
- The margin of error for zeroing reports to constituency level will have significantly larger margin of error.
- The results of each constituency poll presented may represent a statistical noise, and therefore further survey with higher sample size relative to the voters' population in the constituency will be necessary to confirm the findings from this national poll as it relates to the constituency.

Fieldwork:

Interviews were carried out between 1st July – 15th July 2022.

Demographic analysis: Demographic analysis of the poll will have higher margin or error.







Though NPP presidential candidates are winning against John Mahama, the Minister is unbale to benefit from their performance. He appears to be the problem in the constituency.

Conclusion: The Hon Minister for is also in trouble as more than half of the voters are unlikely to vote for her. Majority of NPP voters are unlikely to vote for her (44%). John Mahama currently leads in the constituency, and if JM carried the constituency, we expect the Minister to lose her seat. A swing of less than 5% is required to flip the seat and if the polls are to be correct, we don't see her surviving the onslaught in 2024.

Likelihood of Re-electing MP






