Meeting under the theme "Imperialism in Crisis: Pan-African Solidarity and Socialist

Transformation", the Second National Delegates Congress of the Socialist Movement of Ghana

(SMG) brought together cadres and delegates from across the country to deliberate on the national

and international situation, the work of the youth and women's wings, and to strengthen the

constitution of our movement.

The Congress noted that global capitalism, particularly in its neoliberal phase, is in profound crisis.

The system relies on exploiting workers, extracting resources, and concentrating wealth in the hands

of a few, producing inequality, environmental destruction, and imperialist wars.

These outcomes are not accidental; they are inherent in the system of capitalism and demand

organized, conscious resistance. The growing chaos and violence in international affairs reflect the

long-term death throes of the imperialist system.

Due to the resistance of the working class to exploitation across the world, especially in the Global

South, the Imperialist powers, realising the weakening of their ideological control, are intensifying

the use of brute force to maintain their dominance.

As a revolutionary socialist organization committed to the struggles of the working class and oppressed peoples, the Congress passed the following resolutions:

- We condemn the ongoing genocide against the Palestinian people, carried out by the Israeli apartheid regime with the full backing of US imperialism and its allies, especially Western European states.
- We demand an immediate end to the massacres in Gaza, the dismantling of the apartheid system, and the recognition of the inalienable right of the Palestinian people to self-determination.
- We reaffirm support for the Haitian people—the first to establish an independent Republic of Africans in the modern era—who today face imperialist interventions, economic strangulation, and neocolonial domination.
- We demand the immediate and unconditional lifting of the criminal US blockade imposed on Cuba, and the delisting of Cuba as a State Sponsor of Terrorism.
- We declare our solidarity with the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela and the government of President Nicolás Maduro against imperialist sanctions, destabilisation, and attempts at regime change.
- We condemn Morocco's continued illegal occupation of Western Sahara and call for the full implementation of UN resolutions recognizing the right to self-determination of the Sahrawi people and their independence.
- We reject all forms of imperialist aggression and sanctions against Iran, in violation of its sovereignty and dignity of its people.

- We call for an end to NATO's aggressive expansion in Eastern Europe, which has provoked devastating conflict and destruction, pushing the globe towards a third world war.
- We condemn the plunder of the DRC's vast resources by imperialist powers and their local collaborators, which continues to fuel conflict, displacement, and underdevelopment.
- We salute the heroic struggles of the peoples of Mali, Burkina Faso, and Niger who
  are confronting imperialist domination and asserting their right to sovereignty and
  self-determination.
- We commit the SMG to strengthening Pan-African solidarity with the peoples of the Sahel in their struggle for dignity and independence as they undertake an alternative route to development free from imperialist control.
- The Congress sees the struggles of the African and Caribbean people for Reparations for slavery, colonialism and neo-colonialism as an important effort for the redistribution of surplus value worthy of its support.
- We reaffirm our commitment to the struggles of the working people of Ghana against the capitalist and neoliberal policies that deepen dependency, inequality, poverty, and environmental destruction.
- We call for a halt to the commodification of public goods and services and the privatization of national assets.
- We demand the advancement of democratic participation of workers, women, and youth in all spheres of national life.
